This year the Dante Alighieri Society of Mildura also provided a prize for the best Italian singer in the Classical Singing sections of the Mildura Eisteddfod. At this point we are also working on having a Dante Alighieri Italian Singing section for next year providing another avenue to promote and support students who are using the Italian language in their fields of interest.

Last year we were able to secure prizes for many sections at the Annual Mildura Show. Here we awarded prize money and sashes for the winners of the best Italian style bread, *crostoli* biscuits, olives and oils. This also provided an avenue where the older and younger population (especially Italian) could show their abilities in areas that they are familiar with and good at. This year we will try to include a *salami section* of which the making of these products is prevalent in the Italian community and the community at large of the Mildura district. We also had several age groups for the Venetian Masks that were completed by many students in the district. This was a very popular section and promoted a more glamorous side of the Italian culture.

This year the Mildura Dante Alighieri Society was able to provide some funding to help support a guest lecturer for the Italian teachers in our area. This was attended by many teachers and was very much appreciated seeing they did not have to travel to Melbourne for this calibre of professional development in the teaching of Italian.
